### BLM Hosts Free Fly Fishing Clinic

TAOS – The last Fish Fiestas event of the season is coming to an end this Saturday, July 28, 2001. The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Taos Field Office in conjunction with the Los Rios Anglers, Inc. is hosting a free fly-fishing clinic at the Orilla Verde Campground area in Pilar, New Mexico. This Fish Fiestas, unlike the others that occurred during June and July, will introduce young people, ages 12 to 16, to the craft of fly-fishing.

The casting clinic begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 1200 p.m. Fly-fishing begins at 1:00 p.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. All applicants must bring their fishing license and their own lunch. A legal guardian must accompany children at all times.

There are only 15 slots available, so register with the Los Rios Anglers as soon as possible.
