as well as the UVA women's Polo team. She planned to attend law school but decided to move to Nashville in 1992 and worked briefly as an intern for Arista Records. Later, Templeton was signed by Tony Brown (president of Universal South Records and producer of George Strait and Reba etc) to his BIZZY MUSIC publishing

company where she began to find her voice as a writer.

She followed up by writing for Stewart Harris and Kent Blazy. Along the way, she met and married Sam Gay, and together they have made their home in Nashville. As a singer, Templeton is one of Nashville's most in-demand session vocalists and has performed on stage for audiences around the US, in Europe and in Japan. Her new solo CD entitled "I Remember You" is a testimonial to her ability to draw from her deep well of influences as her music, rooted in country, has a deep soulful edge.


