




Accessing New Mexico Hunting Unit Maps

- To access the hunting maps for the State of New Mexico, go to this website:

<http://www.blm.gov/nm/huntingmaps>

- When the page loads you will need to accept the conditions and download by clicking Accept Conditions/Download at the bottom of the page.



- On the next screen you will see instructions to download the CarryMap Observer application to your mobile device. The application is free of charge. NOTE: Click on the appropriate link for your device or you can use your device's QR Code Scanner and scan the appropriate QR Code below:




iOS



Windows computers do not require a program to download, as it is integrated into the Map files.

- If unsure which units you need to download, click the Index Map link to see an overview of the state with the Game Management Units. For this example Game Management Unit #31 is to be downloaded.



- Click on the link for Units 31 – 40. And under the MOBILE heading click 2014_Hunting_Map_Unit_31.cmf



The download will proceed. When it is finished you can then open the map within the CarryMap Observer application on your device.

NOTE: You need to determine the location of the file after the download, on Android this is usually the "Download" folder.

iOS (Apple iPads, iPhones) users will see a blank page during the download. Please be patient during the download as this is normal. To ensure the download finishes, either keep the screen awake by tapping it every so often, or go to Settings / General / AutoLock and set it to "Never" until downloads are finished. Do not use your device while downloads are in progress and they will finish. You will be prompted to open the map file with CarryMap Observer when the download completes. This may take quite some time depending on the size of the download and your connection speed, please use WiFi if available and be patient. You can also download the files to a desktop computer and move them over to your mobile device using iTunes.
